The increase of monthly retainer from \$300 to \$500, effective July 1, 1958 pursuant to an oral agreement, there being no written contract between the Embassy of Japan and the undersigned registrant, was based on a mutual recognition that my time and effort input has increased to a level not anticipated at the time I was first retained. The increase has not resulted in my rendering additional separate and distinct service and hence there is no change in the substance of service now being rendered pursuant to the increased retainer fee. It has merely involved advice and counsel service with respect to legislation, regulation and administrative actions affecting agriculture and marine products trade between the United States and Japan with greater emphasis upon such actions which may only have an indirect bearing on trade in these two products. Thus, advice and counsel is being rendered from the standpoint of the broader trade picture.
