ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE
FOREIGN AGENTS REGISTRATION ACT OF 1938, AS AMENDED
FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 1950 TO DECEMBER 31, 1954

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TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

I have the honor to report on the administration of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, pursuant to Section 11 of that Act, which requires the Attorney General from time to time to report to the Congress concerning the administration of the Act as well as the nature, source and content of political propaganda disseminated or distributed by agents of foreign principals registered under the terms of the statute.

This report, which deals with the five-year period commencing January 1, 1950 and ending December 31, 1954, summarizes the information contained in the reports previously submitted to the Congress for the calendar years 1950 through 1953, all of which were in supplement to the report submitted for the five-year period commencing January 1, 1945 and ending December 31, 1949. The report will also deal, of course, with the significant developments in 1954.

General

The Foreign Agents Registration Act is administered and enforced in the Department of Justice by the Foreign Agents Registration Section, which was assigned to the Internal Security Division upon the establishment of that Division on July 9, 1954. Previous to that date the Section was assigned to the Criminal Division.

The policy and purpose of the Foreign Agents Registration Act are to protect the national defense, internal security and foreign relations of the United States by requiring public disclosure by persons engaged in propaganda activities and other activities for or on behalf of foreign governments, foreign political parties and other foreign principals, so that the Government and the people of the United States may be informed of the identity of such persons and may appraise their statements and actions in the light of their associations and activities.

The disclosure sought by the statute is accomplished through the filing of a registration statement containing detailed information regarding, among other things, the agent's activities, relationships and finances, and by the filing of supplemental statements at six months intervals in order to keep on a current basis the information contained in the original registration statement. These statements, in accordance with the mandate of the statute, are made available for public inspection. In furtherance of the disclosure envisioned by the Act, each registrant who disseminates any political propaganda through the United States mails or other

instrumentality of interstate commerce is required to label such propaganda so as to advise the recipient thereof of the agent's identity, the identity of the foreign principal, the fact that the disseminator is registered with the Attorney General under the terms of the Act, that his registration statement is available for public inspection and that the fact of registration does not indicate approval of the contents of the propaganda material by the United States Government.

The Act requires each agent of a foreign principal to maintain and keep essential books and records, and officers of the Foreign Agents Registration Section as well as agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation are authorized to conduct inspection of these books and records. While this authority is used sparingly, the FBI during the period covered by this report has at the request of the Foreign Agents Registration Section inspected the books and records of the following registrants: (1) Telegraph Agency of the USSR; (2) Four Continent Book Corporation, which is registered as the agent of Mezhdunarodnaya Kniga, Moscow, W.F.T.U. Publications, Ltd., London, People's China, Hong Kong, and Kultura Hungarian Trading Co., Budapest; (3) Edwin S. Smith, who, under the business names of Sovfoto, Eastfoto, East Music Agency and Am-Rus Literary and Music Agency, is the agent of a number of government agencies in iron curtain countries; and (4) Artkino Pictures, Inc., which is registered as the film distributing agent of Centrala Wynajmu Filmow, Warsaw; Sovrofilm, Bucharest; Sovexportfilm, Moscow; Czechoslovak State Film, Prague; and Magyar Filmgyarto, N.V., Budapest.

Legislative Matters

No amendments to the Foreign Agents Registration Act were enacted, since its thorough-going revision in 1942, until August 3, 1950. By amendment of that date, Congress provided that neither discontinuance of activities which created the agency relationship nor the dissolution of an organization which had been acting as an agent of a foreign principal removed the obligation to file a registration statement for the period during which the agent of a foreign principal acted as such within the United States. Responsibility for effecting the required registration in the case of a dissolved organization was placed upon its officers or directors or persons performing those functions. At the same time it was expressly provided that the obligation to file a registration statement when required by the Act was a continuing one.

The Foreign Agents Registration Act was again amended by Section 20 of Title 1 of the Internal Security Act which became law on September 23, 1950. Section 20(a) amended Section 1(c) of the statute by providing for a new class of agents of foreign principals, namely persons who have knowledge of or have received instruction or assignment in the espionage, counterespionage, or sabotage service or tactics of a government of a foreign country or of a foreign political party. Section 20(b) reemphasized the fact of continuing obligation to register by strengthening the existing legislation and providing that failure to file required registration statements or supplements thereto should be a continuing offense for as long as such failure exists notwithstanding any statute of limitations or

other statute to the contrary.

I am of the opinion that the purposes and objectives of the Congress in enacting Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act of 1950, which is Section 1(c)(5) of the Foreign Agents Registration Act, can be accomplished much more effectively by its removal from the Foreign Agents Registration Act and by the substitution therefor of a separate registration statute which would require the registration of persons who have received assignments or training in the espionage, counterespionage or sabotage service or tactics of a foreign government or foreign political party, irrespective of any technical agency status or relationship. Consequently, by letter of April 29, 1954, and again by letter of January 26, 1955, addressed to the Vice President and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, I recommended to the Congress the enactment of such legislation.

By communication of January 26, 1954, I recommended to the Congress certain other amendments designed to strengthen and clarify the Foreign Agents Registration Act.

As indicated in my report for the calendar year 1953, I proposed, in the first place, that Section 1(b) of the Act be amended by adding thereto a new subsection to include within the term "foreign principal" a domestic organization which is substantially financed, controlled, or directed by a foreign government or foreign political party. This would bring within the purview of the disclosure provisions of the statute agents of such domestic organizations. At present, such agents are not subject to the Act unless it can be established that the domestic organization is subsidized by a

foreign government or foreign political party, even though it is evident that the domestic organization is controlled, supervised, or directed by a foreign government or foreign political party.

I have proposed that Section 3(d) which contains the so-called commercial exemption be clarified. This Section is designed to exempt from the registration provisions an agency of the ordinary private commercial character whose activities are in furtherance of the bona fide trade and commerce of a foreign principal. When Section 3(d) was first enacted, there did not exist to the same degree the control of business enterprises by governments such as exists today, nor was the operation of such business enterprises utilized by foreign governments to the same extent as instruments of national policy as is now the case. I believe it was the intention to include within the 3(d) exemption provisions only those commercial and financial agents who act within the United States on behalf of private interests and not those who further the political or public interests of a foreign government or foreign political party through commercial or financial activity. Accordingly, I have recommended certain clarifying changes in Section 3(d) to assist the Department in its administration of the Act by defining more exactly the nature of the activity which will entitle an agent of a foreign principal to the commercial exemption.

Included among the other recommendations is one to amend Sections 4(a) and 4(b) so as to require all political propaganda disseminated through the United States mails or other instrumentality

of interstate commerce to be filed and labeled without regard to whether it is intended to be disseminated among two or more persons. The present wording of these Sections has been construed in the past to mean that the filing and labeling of political propaganda is required only when an agent disseminates political propaganda which he believes will be, or which he intends to be, disseminated or circulated among two or more persons. While we do not so interpret the Act at present, I believe it important that the intention of the Congress be made clear that these Sections apply to require the filing and labeling without regard to the question of whether the propaganda is intended to be disseminated among two or more persons.

Further, I have recommended the inclusion of a new subsection (e) to be added to Section 4 of the Act to embody the present Rule 50 as an integral part of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. Rule 50 was promulgated under the rule-making power of the Attorney General and provides in substance that any person outside the United States who uses the United States mails or other instrumentalities of interstate or foreign commerce to circulate or disseminate political propaganda shall be considered as acting within the United States and subject to the disclosure provisions of the statute. This Rule, which is based upon an Opinion of the Attorney General of December 10, 1940, is being used at the present time by the Post Office Department and by the Bureau of Customs in declaring non-mailable, or seizing, political propaganda which is not handled in accordance with the disclosure provisions of the Foreign

Agents Registration Act. Because of the present importance of Rule 50 in combating the increased communist propaganda directed at this country from abroad, I am of the opinion that this Rule should become an integral part of the statute and directly express the intent of the Congress.

Statistical Summary

As of December 31, 1954, a total of 861 registration statements have been filed since June 1942, when the administration of the Foreign Agents Registration Act was transferred by executive order of the President from the Department of State to the Department of Justice. In the five-year period covered by this report, 259 registration statements were filed by agents of foreign principals as defined in subsections (1) through (4) of Section 1(c) of the Act. In addition, during this period 76 individuals filed registration statements as a result of the agency status being created by Section 1(c)(5) of the statute which, as previously indicated, is Section 20(a) of the Internal Security Act of 1950. These statements, designated as Exhibit G registrations, are listed in Appendix VI of this report.

A total of 201 registration statements were terminated during this five-year period, leaving 271 active registration statements on file at the end of the calendar year 1954. This represents the greatest number of active registration statements on file at the end of any one year since the administration of the Act was assigned to the Department of Justice. An alphabetical list of all persons whose statements were in an active status at any time

during the five-year period, including names of the foreign principals and a brief description of the nature of the agency, is contained in Appendix II, while a list by registration number of the statements filed during the period will be found in Appendix I.

A functional analysis of the registration statements filed during the five-year period reveals, as is to be expected, that the largest number has been filed in connection with propaganda activities in one form or another. Thus, a total of 91 statements were filed by persons engaging in publicity, advertising and public relations activities. The second largest number of statements was filed during the period by those engaged in legal and economic consulting services, and the third largest by commercial and financial agents. The comparatively large number of registrants in the latter two categories results in part from the amendments enacted in 1942 which broadened the definition of the term "agent of a foreign principal" to include agents who are not necessarily engaged in propaganda activities. A functional analysis of all statements filed during the period January 1, 1950 through December 31, 1954, is contained in Appendix III.

When a registration statement is filed by a partnership, corporation, association, organization, or other combination of individuals, each partner, officer, director, or other person rendering assistance to the registrant on behalf or in the interests of the foreign principal is required to file a short form registration statement designated as an Exhibit A. Utilization of this exhibit avoids a multiplicity of registrations on behalf of the same foreign

principal in the conduct of one obligation. At the same time it effects compliance with Rule 201(a), promulgated under the terms of the Act, which states in substance that the filing of a registration statement by a partnership, corporation, association, organization or other combination of individuals shall not remove the necessity of filing a registration statement by employees, associates and affiliates of such registrant who are required to register under the statute. During the period covered by this report, 1,301 Exhibits A were filed, and these are listed alphabetically in Appendix IV. The identity of the registrant may be determined by reference to Appendix I through correlation of the registration number.

Nature, Source and Content
of Political Propaganda

By far the largest source of political propaganda disseminated in the United States continues to be from foreign governments and foreign political parties which are primarily interested in creating good-will for their respective countries and presenting before the American public their viewpoints on various international issues.

Neither the nature nor content of political propaganda disseminated during the calendar year 1954 has altered in any material respect from that as described in previous reports to Congress. Propaganda material has continued to consist of books, pamphlets, magazines, news releases, special reports, film, recordings, radio broadcasts and other media of information. The bulk consists of publications designed to present in as favorable light as possible the country responsible for their issuance with a view toward

attracting tourist trade and commercial investment. The propaganda activities of these governments are conducted mainly from official information and tourist offices by subsidized agents or from official diplomatic missions.

Of the 79 countries maintaining diplomatic missions in the United States as given in the diplomatic list (Blue Book) issued by the Department of State in February 1955, thirty-two maintain either a separate information or tourist office or both within this country. (This figure does not include several Middle Eastern countries which established the Arab Information Center early in 1955). The majority of those remaining, including the so-called iron curtain countries, maintain cultural attaches or press officers as part of their diplomatic staffs who engage in informational activity in connection with the operation of the mission.

Official government information and tourist offices reported a total expenditure for the year 1954 of nearly six million dollars and had approximately 545 employees. The magnitude of the effort to attract tourist traffic is reflected in the expenditure made by the British Travel Association, which reported nearly \$960,000 in 1954. In the same category it is noteworthy that the French Government Tourist Office expended nearly \$650,000 in that year. Generally, during the five-year period covered by this report, official government information and tourist offices maintained their expenditures and number of employees at fairly constant levels. A complete list of all government information and tourist offices registered under the terms of the Act, including the amounts they spent within the

United States, will be found in Appendix VII.

As is to be expected, the content of political propaganda changes with the international scene in order to reflect the country's viewpoint on the many international issues in which it may be interested. Significant amounts of propaganda material were disseminated by representatives of political parties and countries seeking independence, such as French Morocco and Tunisia, and by representatives of underground movements abroad working for the independence of countries over-run or dominated by the Soviet Union. Included in this category are a number of international movements which still protest the settlements reached at Versailles after World War I and which seek independence and national existence for countries or provinces consolidated into Yugoslavia and Czechoslovakia.

Neither the Soviet Union nor any of its satellites maintains a separate information office within this country. Since the informational activities of these countries are conducted by their diplomatic missions, no estimate as to the amount of money expended in this country for such purposes can be made within the framework of a report dealing with disclosures required under the Foreign Agents Registration Act. Information as to the type of publications transmitted into the United States by the Soviet Union and its satellites was set forth in some detail in my reports to the Congress for the calendar years 1952 and 1953. No marked change was noted for the calendar year 1954, with the exception that in this year there was undertaken the dissemination of an English edition of the VOLKS Bulletin, a bimonthly published by the USSR Society for Cultural

Relations with Foreign Countries.

The principal outlets in the United States for propaganda and other material from the Soviet Union and Soviet bloc nations continue to be (1) Four Continent Book Corporation (2) Edwin S. Smith, doing business as Eastfoto and Sovfoto (3) Imported Publications and Products and (4) Artkino Pictures, Inc.

In recent years the presence within this country of a considerable number of Cuban exiles, both voluntary and involuntary, has caused a marked rise in the dissemination of political propaganda in the Cuban nationality field, resulting from attempts by these persons to enlist United States support for their cause. At the same time the Batista Government of Cuba, as to be expected, sought to counteract this propaganda with material of its own. Another factor which resulted in marked increase in propaganda activity in this nationality field is the fact that Congress will soon have before it a measure dealing with sugar quotas. Agents representing the Cuban sugar interests naturally have intensified their efforts to place that country in as favorable a light as possible. Similarly, other sugar exporting countries have retained counsel or representatives in this country to present their position in order to secure favorable treatment under any new sugar quota law. Agents representing the sugar interests of Peru, Mexico and the Philippines have duly filed registration statements under the terms of the Foreign Agents Registration Act.

Some of the principal propaganda trends noted during 1954, based on the material filed with the Foreign Agents Registration

Section, and the countries to which the material relates, are:

Japan. Its propaganda was mainly concerned with material designed to promote the commercial interests of that country with particular emphasis on the development and growth of air transport between the United States and Japan. Visiting Japanese dignitaries and, particularly, the visit of Prime Minister Yoshida were the subjects of considerable material disseminated by Japanese registered agents. The Japanese Consulate in San Francisco began issuing during 1954 a publication entitled "Japanese Bulletin," dealing with military, political and economic matters.

China. Much of Nationalist China's propaganda is disseminated by the Chinese News Service whose releases set forth the hopes and faith of the Chiang Government in the eventual liberation of the Chinese mainland from communist control.

Germany. The Press and Information Office of the West German Government issues a weekly bulletin which contains information regarding internal developments in West Germany and its viewpoint on those international matters which affect it. In addition, the Information Office issues regular releases which, in 1954, touched on such matters as President Adenauer's visit to the United States, the agricultural progress of Germany, statistical reports on expellees and technical problems involved in any future unification of Germany. Also disseminated within the United States was a publication called "News from Germany," published by the Executive Committee of the Social Democratic Party and whose principal theme was "Young Germans Do Not Want To Be Soldiers."

Great Britain. This country maintains the largest budget for informational purposes of all foreign countries operating official government information and tourist offices within the United States. Its propaganda material is quite diversified and consists not only of various types of publications, but photographs, motion picture film, posters and maps, as well. The British Information Services in the United States also arrange for numerous lectures to be given by members of its staff or visiting dignitaries. While considerable quantities of its propaganda material are designed to present Great Britain as an attractive tourist country, other material is intended to place before the American public Great Britain's views with respect to what it considers the major international issues such as its position regarding the Suez Canal, important diplomatic conferences, the problems attendant on the Korean peace, Far Eastern problems, and so forth.

Greece. While this country conducts most of its informational activity from its Embassy, information regarding it has been made available as a result of the registration in 1954 of George S. Charles, an information-service employee of the Embassy. In accordance with the requirements of the Act, the Foreign Agents Registration Section has been advised that the Embassy regularly issues press releases and a bulletin, "Hellenic News." It also disseminates an illustrated pamphlet called "Greece," containing historical facts about that country.

India. This country's views on world affairs, personalities in the news, and international issues, are reflected in

publications issued by the Embassy and by the Information Service of India. The Service supplies information regarding India and its affairs by the issuance of periodical releases and bulletins, the distribution and loan of films, photographs, maps, posters, and the like. The Information Service offers to render necessary assistance to schools and other institutions in connection with educational and cultural programs regarding India. Some of the subjects touched upon include India's voting record in the United Nations, a biographical sketch of Jawaharlal Nehru; the dispute with Portugal regarding Goa; religious freedom in India, and Nehru's analysis of India's foreign policy.

Indonesia. The Information Office of the Republic of Indonesia issues a bimonthly and a monthly bulletin, both known as "Report on Indonesia." In these reports the Government points out the economic gains made in Indonesia during past years as well as its progress in the fields of education and public health. A good deal of space has been devoted to the country's relationships, both past and present, with the Netherlands and the efforts of the Indonesian Government to gain control of West Irian (New Guinea).

Israel. The Israel Office of Information releases over a hundred different items of propaganda each month, a number of which are devoted to explaining Israel's position in its continuous dispute with certain Arab countries. It also distributes pictorial material regarding the country's geography, finances and resources, in furtherance of its efforts to attract foreign capital and investment. The Israel Government Tourist Office disseminates brochures

and leaflets designed to attract American tourists.

France. While France maintains an official government tourist office, a considerable amount of propaganda material is disseminated within the United States by the Washington, D. C. office of Comite France Actuelle, an association with headquarters in Paris, subsidized by the Conseil National du Patronat Francais. The publications disseminated by Comite France Actuelle comment on such varied topics as women's fashions, an upsurge in mineral output, France's position in the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, the political situation in Tunisia, and the visit of Mendes-France to the United States. As is to be expected, the publications issued by the French Government tourist office point out France's attraction for the American tourist.

As in the past, many foreign countries continue to rely upon American public relations firms and consultants for advice as to the nature and content of their propaganda material circulated within this country. Thus, in 1954 Afghanistan retained the firm of Schaler, Butler & Associates. The Japanese Government also retains that firm and Charles von Loewenfeldt & Associates. The Spanish Embassy employs Messrs. Felipe F. G. Armesto and Anatole Visson as advisers. Yugoslavia has recently employed the Edward L. Greenfield Company and the Union of South Africa retained Krock-Erwin Associates, Inc. Ethiopia has hired Forrest E. Finley & Associates, the Dominican Republic has employed International Services, Inc., and Cuba utilizes the Hoite Agey Advertising, Inc. Greece has retained Kelly, Nason, Inc. and Egypt employs the firm of Sessions & Caminita. Appendix VIII contains

a summary showing the amounts of money received by American individuals and organizations from their foreign principals during the five-year period covered by this report, and included therein will be found the names of all American public relations advisers and consultants who have been retained by foreign governments during this period.

A list of registered agents whose statements were in an active status as of December 31, 1954, set forth according to geographical area or nationality field, will be found in Appendix V.


Enforcement

Indicative of the extent to which voluntary compliance with the disclosure provisions of the Act is obtained is the fact that it was found necessary to bring but one prosecution during this five-year period charging wilful violation of the Foreign Agents Registration Act. This proceeding was brought against the now defunct Peace Information Center, which was responsible for the dissemination within the United States of the so-called Stockholm Peace Appeal. The indictment charged the Center with failure to register as the agent of the Committee of the World Congress of the Defenders of Peace. The case, which came to trial in the District of Columbia on November 8, 1951, was dismissed by the trial judge on defense motion upon completion of the Government's case. The defense motion upon which the judge ruled was based upon a case decided under the Foreign Agents Registration Act prior to the 1942 amendments in which the court had held it was incumbent upon the Government, in order to sustain prosecution for failure to register,

to establish an agency relationship as defined by the Restatement of the Law of Agency. It was the Government's contention, however, that the Foreign Agents Registration Act as amended in 1942 had substituted the statutory definition for the common-law definition of the term "agent."

During the period covered by this report, the Department has continued to rely on its normal sources of information and the investigative efforts of the Federal Bureau of Investigation in the administration and enforcement of the statute. The Department has continued in administering the Act to emphasize its main and original purpose -- the full disclosure of activities within the United States by agents of foreign principals who are engaged in political propaganda activities.
